s many of you know, James has spent his Aentire career offering poignant statements for mankind through what he terms "Allegorical Art." His reputation as an historical and allegorical artist has motivated him to do many pieces that address world issues as well as the highest and best in mankind, such as duty, honor, courage, justice, and the triumph of the human spirit. James' work expanded over the years from mostly historical to include contemporary subjects with an array of artistic commentary on the human social, political and spiritual condition to exemplify the highest qualities of man that reflect the critical nature of the times in which we live. His book "Lanterns Along The Path" and recent works continue to address those concepts.

In deed, he has been especially busy since moving back to Sedona with many other lifesize/monumental pieces and commissions being completed which include:

The 9 foot "American Pieta" located in Golden, L Colorado and Chicago, Illinois; the 20 foot Christ "Walk With Me" which was installed in Texas (First United Methodist Church Richardson) February 6; the lifesize "Lil' Liberty & Let Freedom Ring" in Sedona, Arizona at Red Rock News July'08, a 7 foot "The Dance" that has gone into several locations including uptown Sedona, downtown Colorado Springs, and in Oregon-Pioneer Park Museum; the lifesize Mexican hero Elfego Baca was dedicated on May 24th in Reserve, New Mexico. (This sculpture also won the prestigious Olaf Weighorst Best of Show Award at the Tucson Mountain Oyster Show November '06.) Each of these do have maquette sizes available. Other new tablesize pieces include: the Arizona Ranger, "Monsoon on The Mogollon" - and a corresponding Texas Ranger, "On The Border".

77 orks in-progress and others completed include: the lifesize Thomas Jefferson monument commissioned for USMA @ West Point's new Jefferson Library Rotunda by James' Class of '68 – this will be installed September 5th '08, the Sedona Humane Society's signature pieces "Hound of Heaven-Soul of The Cat" to be dedicated September 13th; a tablesize commissioned historical "civil war" action sculpture "Cry Freedom" (which will be completed in time for the annual Mountain Oyster Show); a lifesize commission of a pioneer couple "East Meets West"; "The Last Horseman" (a civil war confederate cavalryman); and an early aviator "Visions of Flight".

There is much to still be accomplished and no rest for James until these commissions are completed and installed....Then he gets a much needed hiatus to decide what's next......since he is never at a loss for ideas. I am sure it will be great-whatever it is!

e do still have the 12 ft. sculpture"Caduceus" available which is a very powerful piece that addresses universal issues of healing the earth and all its inhabitants. As some of you know, ultimately this piece will also be available at the heroic size of 39 feet high to a very special audience. She will be offered for placement on each of the seven continents to individuals who want to memorialize "world healing and peace". Do you know 7 philanthropists or organizations who want to leave that kind of legacy in their name?!
